Keswick Hall

Keswick, VA

Located two hours southwest of Washington, D.C. just outside of Charlottesville, Keswick will probably be lesser known than many of the resorts on this list. While this boutique hotel is smaller, it's chock-full of quality. Jean-Georges has a restaurant there called Marigold, and the spa does not cut any corners. The T-shaped infinity pool is a great place to lounge, and the newly redesigned tennis facility features European red clay surfaces. Pete and Alice Dye redesigned the layout in 2013 and Dye protege Scot Sherman recently renovated the course, one of the best in central Virginia.
