Charlottesville, Virginia

Bucolic Charlottesville, with its numerous hiking, biking, and wine trails has long been a favored weekend trip destination, even if you're not visiting the stunning campus of the <u>University of Virginia</u> (UVA). But two new hotels have made the city even more alluring.

<u>Keswick Hall</u>, a sprawling resort with everything from seven tennis courts to <u>Marigold by Jean-Georges</u>, an on-site restaurant by famed chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten, unveiled a full renovation in the fall of 2021. And just this April, the city welcomed the opening of <u>Kimpton The Forum Hotel</u>, right on the grounds of UVA's Darden School of Business. The Kimpton property is the brand's first on-campus hotel and includes modern steakhouse <u>Birch & Bloom</u> and craft beer bar <u>The Good Sport</u>.
